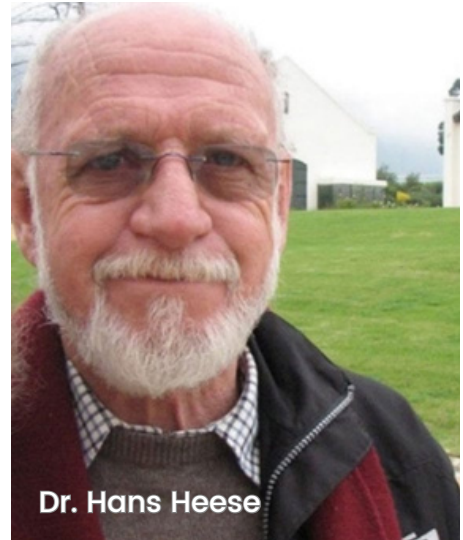

Dit is met groot hartseer dat ons verneem het van dr. Hans Heese se afsterwe op Maandag, 18 Maart 2024 te Stellenbosch. Dr. Heese was een van die mees gerekende geskiedskrywers en deskundige op die gebied van die bevolkingsamestelling van die vroeë Kaap, en veral die slawegeskiedenis. Hy was 'n skrywer, navorser, en professor, en het bekendheid verwerf vir sy baanbrekerswerk *Groep sonder Grense* (1985). Hy was ook as 'n reus in die wêreld van genealogie geag.

Dr. Heese se heengaan laat 'n groot leemte en hy sal gemis word.



In Memoriam

It is with great sadness that we learned of Dr. Hans Heese's death on Monday, 18 March 2024 at Stellenbosch. Dr. Heese was considered one of the greatest historians and an expert on the population composition of the early Cape, and especially regarding the history of slavery. He was a writer, researcher and professor, who was known for his ground breaking work *Groep sonder Grense* (1985). He was also regarded as a giant within the field of genealogy.

Dr Heese leaves a substantial void and will be missed.

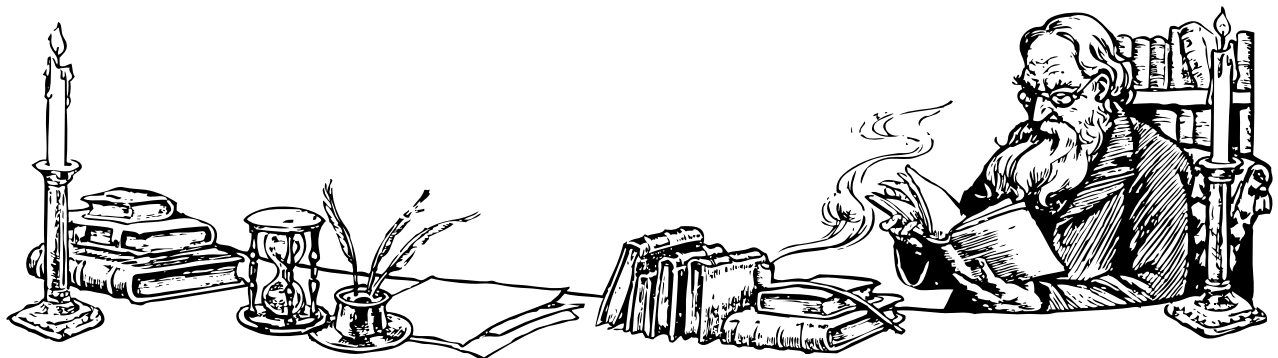

Theme: Labour, Migration and Agency in Southern African History

The Regional Historical Society of Southern Africa, established by a consortium of universities hold its first ever face-to-face annual conference after two virtual webinars in respectively 2022 and 2023, will in partnership with the School of Social Sciences at the North-West University and the Department of Historical and Archaeological Studies at the University of Zambia. This face-to-face conference will take place in Lusaka, Zambia on 25 and 26 November 2024.

Africa has been viewed as a continent of mass migration and displacement occasioned by economic deprivation, conflict, and environmental degradation. Migration dynamics in southern Africa have, since time immemorial, been complex. For centuries, the region has been a place of the origin, transit, and destination of men, women, and children on the move.

These migrants have either moved to new places which they in turn made their permanent homes or in some cases, migrated with the intention of returning home after a limited period. People in southern Africa have historically migrated because of various pull and push factors ranging from the search for better economic opportunities, to escaping monotonous village life, and the desire to earn money to pay newly introduced colonial taxes. In the modern era, southern Africa experiences a high volume of migration among different age groups owing to work opportunities in various economic sectors such as mining, manufacturing, and agriculture in more economically advanced countries. Others, however, migrate for a myriad of political or social reasons.

The migration of people in southern Africa has contributed to a more flexible labour market, and a large pool of skills from which employers are able to tap. It has also led to personal benefits for migrants and their families such as an improved livelihood, educational opportunities, and safety from political prosecution at home. On the other hand, communities hosting migrants have, in some cases, complained about their own dwindling economic possibilities due to the presence of foreign labour in their midst - leading, in the most severe cases, to xenophobic attacks. The RHSSA therefore saw it fit to host a conference on the theme Labour, Migration and Agency in Southern African History. We cordially invite you to consider joining us for this debate!

Voortrekkermonument se Pioniersentrum kry nuwe uitstalling

Die opvoedkundige sentrum wat in 2019 geopen is op die Voortrekkermonumentterrein sal vanaf 5 April 2024 weer oop wees vir die publiek met 'n nuwe uitstalling. Die Pioniersentrum, 'n interaktiewe opvoedkundige sentrum, vertel die storie van die Afrikaner se kultuurgeskiedenis en -erfenis na die Groot Trek tot die Anglo-Boereoorlog (1854 - 1902). Die sentrum bestaan uit verskeie areas vir 'leer', 'vat-enoel' en 'aktiwiteitsruimtes' sodat kinders op 'n prettige manier meer oor hulle herkoms kan leer. Dit sluit ook aan by talle tradisionele aktiwiteite wat op die sentrum se werf beoefen word insluitend tradisionele broodbak, boeresport, en perdry.

Hierdie uitstalling vorm deel van die terrein se geheelbeeld om 'n kronologiese tydlyn te skep op die Voortrekkermonument-terrein. Hier kan besoekers en skoliere meer kom leer oor die Afrikaner se geskiedenis en herkoms vanaf die Groot Trek (Voortrekkermonument en trekroete tuin), die Republieke se vestigingsjare (Pioniersentrum), die Anglo-Boereoorlog (Fort Schanskop) tot en met die hede (Toekomsbou Museumteater).
